Dear Friends, Family, and Fabulous Community,

As we open the pages of this year's Leicester Pride Magazine and step into another celebration of who we are, vibrant, diverse, united. We do so with hearts full of love and eyes wide open to the reality around us. 2025 has not been an easy year for many in our LGBTQ+ family, and especially for our trans siblings, who have faced relentless, cruel scrutiny, political targeting, and an unprecedented level of media-fuelled hostility.

The recent Supreme High Court ruling that restricts access to public toilets for trans and non-binary individuals is not just a legal decision, it's a human one, with real-life consequences. It's a ruling that tells members of our family they are not welcome in the everyday spaces so many take for granted. It sends a message of exclusion, of fear, of othering. And we, the Leicester Pride Committee, want to be crystal clear: we utterly reject that message.

We stand proudly, firmly, and visibly with our trans and non-binary siblings. You are not a debate. You are not a distraction. You are not a problem to be solved. You are cherished, essential members of our community, and Leicester Pride is your Pride.

This year, more than ever, our theme is unity. Unity not as a buzzword, but as a powerful, necessary act of resistance and love. It is only through standing shoulder to shoulder whether you're gay, lesbian, bisexual, trans, queer, non-binary, intersex, asexual or an ally - that we can weather the storms we face and emerge stronger, louder, prouder.

But while it's been a year of hardship, it has also been a year of bravery. We have seen trans activists and allies speak truth to power. We've seen grassroots networks grow, mutual aid flourish, and local communities rally in support of one another. From the steps of Parliament to the streets of Leicester, people have said "enough is enough." This Pride, we echo that cry. Enough of division. Enough of scapegoating. Enough of pretending equality has been achieved when so many still live in fear.

But there is hope. Always hope. Because hope lives in every person who dares to live authentically. Hope lives in the parent who embraces their child's identity with open arms. Hope lives in the teachers, the artists, the youth groups, and community leaders working quietly and fiercely behind the scenes to make our city a better place for LGBTQ+ people to live, work, and love.











ALEXIS BLAKE

Alexis Blake is a familiar face to thousands on TikTok. A bold, brilliant trans woman using her platform to inspire, educate, and uplift.

With her trademark warmth and unshakeable honesty, Alexis shares her life, love, and journey of self-discovery with humour and heart. Now, she's stepping onto the Leicester Pride stage as host for the very first time. In this exclusive interview, Alexis opens up about the power of visibility, the strength of community, and the joy of living as your authentic self. No filter, just truth.



How does it feel to be stepping onto the Pride stage as a host for the first time?

I'm terrified and so grateful to be asked. I grew up attending Prides and being involved in them. They're incredibly important to celebrate LGBTO+ people and protest with love.

As a proud trans woman, what does Pride mean to you personally, especially in a year that's been so tough for the trans community across the UK?

Pride has always been a safe space for me to be my authentic self. It's more crucial than ever for our community to stand together.

This year, we've seen so many attacks on trans rights, especially around public spaces. How do you stay grounded and resilient when the world feels heavy?

I try to stay level-headed and show that trans people aren't a threat. We've always existed.

Representation matters so much, especially for trans people. What would you say to young trans folks who might be seeing someone like them on a Pride stage for the first time?

It's okay to be you - whatever that means. The world can be dark, but you'll find light with people who support you. Surround yourself with them. Don't rush the journey - it's a marathon, not a race. Only do what makes you happy, not anyone else.



You're known for your charisma, courage, and voice. When did you first discover your passion for performance and the spotlight?

Before transitioning, I was a professional male dancer. Being on stage was a thrill. When I accepted I had to transition, I knew my performing career was over. I gave it up to become the real me. Now, creating content lights that same fire in me. I'm grateful to have the platforms I do.

Who were your trans or queer role models growing up, and how have they shaped your journey?

Kim Petras helped me relate to being trans. She was a teen girl sharing how she felt she was supposed to be: a girl - it resonated deeply with me.

Pride is a celebration, but it's also a protest. How do you balance joy and activism in your work, and what message do you hope to share from the stage on August 30th?

History is always being made. The tide will turn and things will get better. I'll keep sharing my life to show what being trans means to me.

In such divisive times, community means everything. What does a supportive LGBTQ+ scene look like to you, and how can we help build that all year round?

Keep having open conversations. Be honest and share feelings, while respecting that we all have our own views. Everyone deserves basic human rights. It's easy to turn away from trans people because we're the current target, but I believe that target will shift. We must stick together.

You've spoken beautifully on TikTok and Instagram about Liam. How has his love and support shaped your journey, personally and publicly, as a trans woman?

He's always been my number one cheerleader. He made my transition easier because he accepted me, the real me, even before I did.

Transitioning with a partner by your side can be deeply emotional. Were there moments during that journey where you both grew stronger in unexpected ways?

Facing online hate brought us closer. People couldn't understand how Liam could stay with me after I transitioned. His unwayering love and standing up to trolls definitely made us stronger.

We don't often hear enough about joyful, affirming love stories in the trans community. What would you say to someone who's scared they won't find love after coming out?

No one can truly love you until you're living as your true self. Only then can you learn to love yourself.

Finally, if you could leave the Leicester crowd with one message at the end of Pride, especially for our trans and non-binary family, what would it be?

I promise it gets better. There's a lot of hate right now, but we're not going anywhere. We're a small percentage - so allies, please speak up, make your voices heard, and be proud of who you are.




